he first and second prizes will be a trip to Helsinki for the two winning teams and their teacher/tutor to take part in the **European vocational skills week** gala dinner and award ceremony on 17 and 18 October 2019.

The Cedefop prix du jury will be a trip to Thessaloniki for the winning team and a teacher/tutor for the opening ceremony of the **Thessaloniki international film festival** on 31 October 2019. Cedefop and the European Commission will cover the cost for the participation of the winning teams and their teachers/tutors in the events (travel expenses and accommodation for each trip).



he competition ends on **31 May 2019** at **23:59 CET** (deadline for submission of the photo stories). The three winning and the selected runner-up photo stories will be exhibited at the Thessaloniki international film festival (31 October to 10 November 2019) and during the European vocational skills week in Helsinki (14 to 18 October 2019).
